Damping – different methods of damping can be used to observe note values and to produce different sounds, such as holding the bell against a soft surface/table immediately after ringing. Plucking – the name given to the technique of moving the clapper with your fingers to make it strike the bell, rather than ringing it by holding the handle.

Introduction to Change-ringing

The main cause of ringing artifacts is due to a signal being bandlimited (specifically, not having high frequencies) or passed through a low-pass filter; this is the frequency domain description. In terms of the time domain, the cause of this type of ringing is the ripples in the sinc function, which is the impulse response (time domain representation) of a perfect low-pass filter.

The second type of skill is the cognitive process of learning 'change-ringing': the 'music' that is rung on bells (see below for an introduction to what this means). Most people will be able to start this within a few weeks of beginning to learn, but it depends largely on their ability to handle a bell comfortably.
